This Senior "Study" package is formatted for use by both the Experienced & Intermediate Divisions. It is based on the entirety of the 2026 "Bible Doctrine" (Selected throughout the Bible) study. This package's 1-time, 2-time, and 3-time word lists are based on the Experienced verses of study. Generally, questions for UPCI National events (BQEs, District Finals, and National Finals) are written using the Experienced word lists, with the only difference between divisions being in the verses covered. To help Intermediate quizzers, verses that only apply to the Experienced division (Sec 4C1 - 4D3) are identified with a gray highlight (Eph 5:18, for example).

"Chart by Section" will be available in the 2026 Material

The "Chart by Section" is a summary, by section, of the similar, repeated, and unique phrases. And is similar to what we provide for the Junior Materials. It will be a separate product (009c1 Senior Charting Materials by Section) and will be available 12/01/25 at a cost of \$20.

Once again, in this year's "Study" package are **"Black & White Study/Quote"** pages. Since reproduction of these is permitted, they are helpful for your quizzers to learn from (if they don't have our Color Coded Pages), as well to use for "highlighting" missed words or phrases when quizzers quote the material they have learned

This "Study" Package contains a lot of detailed information on the verses of study, but **REMEMBER, the priority** is for quizzers to learn their verses of study. The quizzers should be able to quote the verses accurately and reference them (be able to quote the verse when given the reference) quickly. After the quizzers "know" their verses, the next beneficial item for your quizzes to focus on is "one-time words", since this uniquely identifies a verse based on a word found once in our study. A summary of the **1-time**, **2-time**, and **3-time** words, are found in this "Study" package in alphabetic verses of study and learning order. **1-time**, **2-time**, and **3-time** words are identified by **"blue," "green," and "red"** fonts on our color-coded materials. If you have an Apple, Android or Kindle smartphone or tablet, check out our BibleQuizzer APP available in the APP store for your device. Search "BibleQuizzer" in the APP store. The "free" app requires an "in APP purchase" of a Beginner/Junior or Intermediate/Experienced module for \$5.99 each. Also, check out our "QuizBook" book (item 007), a comprehensive quizzer resource.

This "Study" package is a **"resource" for your Bible Quiz Ministry** that you can use at quiz practice to enhance your team's knowledge of the material and to prepare for tournaments. 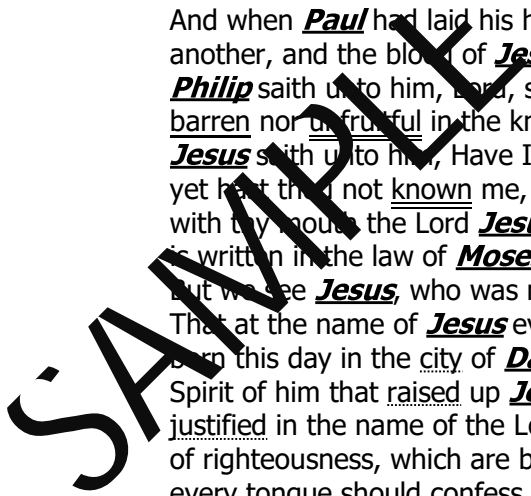
